

Welcome to KITES Vacation Care. Please find attached the holiday program and information that will assist your attendance at Vacation Care. We look forward to our association with you and your family. This program will run from <u>Friday 20<sup>th</sup> Dec 2019 until Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020.</u>

the service is available for 5 - 12 year olds (inclusive).

This program will be run by Joanie Coker, Dionne Collis, Samantha Lane and Donna Nibbs, alongside educators from Circular Head Children's Services Inc.

### The venue for the program will be Anzac Park Playrooms 33A King Street, Smithton.

Vacation Care operates between the hours of 8am and 6pm, care prior to 8am can be provided - arranged through our Long Day Care Centre from 6:45am (children who utilise this service we will require a permission slip signed and risk assessment acknowledgement.)

#### WHAT TO BRING:

<u>Children will need to bring their own nutritious lunch, snacks and drink unless the program states otherwise</u>. We encourage good health through a nutritious diet and ask that you avoid packing sweets for your children. KITES children are busy children and require plenty of food and drinks to get them through a program day. Meal times are social times and often children eat more whilst in care than they would at home. We have a fridge available for perishable foods and a microwave for heating ready to eat foods.

#### It is important to advise staff of any food allergies that your child may have.

In accordance with our Sun Smart policy all children are required to apply sunscreen 2 hourly and wear their own (named) <u>broad brimmed</u> or <u>legionnaire</u> style hats when the UV index rating is 3 or above. <u>Peaked caps are NOT</u> permitted. KITES Vacation Care provide Guardian brand sunscreen, if your child is sensitive to this brand please supply an alternative. Children are also encouraged to wear clothing which covers their shoulders and <u>must</u> wear a rash vest or t-shirt when swimming outdoors in order to minimise sun exposure.

On wet days we observe the "shoes off inside" rule, your child may like to bring some slippers on these days.

Damp days don't always stop us from doing scheduled outdoor activities - please send a coat just in case!

#### ON ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

It is important for security reasons and for our records that ALL children be signed in and out of the service. The sign in/out sheets are kept on the front desk and staff can help you with completing them. Staff observe the rule that you, the parent, collect the child. The staff will not give your child to anyone who does not have authorisation to collect your child. Staff must be told if you wish someone else to collect your child; authorisation can be given by a written statement (with signature) from the parent/guardian.

#### **EXCURSIONS**

Please refer to the program sheet for excursion details prior to arriving at the service. Actual departure and return times will be available from KITES staff 1 week prior to the excursion and will be posted on the CH Child Care's Facebook page the day before.

If swimming is scheduled please ensure your child's gear is named and in a waterproof bag.

On all KITES excursions we ask children to wear OUR HATS for supervision purposes.

Your child may like to bring 2 drinks and some extra food on long excursion days.

#### ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Electronic devices such as iPods/iPads and DS' are not permitted at KITES unless otherwise stated on the program. Mobile phones are not encouraged at KITES however you may sign a contract if your child needs to have a phone with them. Usage will be at educator discretion.

#### POLICY AND PROCEDURES

KITES have a policy document governing many aspects of our daily operations. This policy document is readily available for parents - please ask a staff member if you would like to view any of our policies and procedures, they can point you in the right direction.

#### **FEEDBACK**

It is important to us that your child's time at vacation care is a happy and rewarding time, we encourage families to communicate with our staff if there are any hiccups along the way. We are here to work in partnership with you to provide safe and happy play spaces.

We value your feedback and would love to hear your thoughts on our programmed activities, daily practise and environments, feel free to pull our staff aside anytime for a chat!

#### RISK ASSESSMENTS

All routine and planned excursions have detailed risk assessments available for families' perusal. These assessments are completed prior to the start of vacation care and will be available for families at our sign-in desk or alternatively a PDF copy is available on the services Ipad. Please take the time to read through these Risk Assessments.

#### PERMISSION SLIPS

Please complete and return the permission slip on the back of the program ASAP. We are required by our governing standards to have them with us at all times whilst not in the service building. Permission slips must be filled out for each holiday program.
